VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a second petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR no.223 dated 31.10.2016 registered under Sections 323, 307, 324, 506, 148, 149 and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 09.12.2021, this Court was pleased to direct the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements qua compromise within a period of one month and the concerned Court was directed to submit its report.

In pursuance of the said order, report has been submitted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya. As per which, neither of the parties had come present in the Court for recording their statements.

Case has been called on three occasions. None appeared on

behalf of the petitioner. It is, thus, apparent that the compromise has not been fructified. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition for quashing of the above said FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is still effectual and the parties are ready to get the statements recorded before the trial Court.
