The present petition has been filed seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, which according to the petitioner, is under threat at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner had already brought to the notice of the police authorities the said grievance vide representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5).

This Court issued notice of motion and directed the State to file status report qua the allegations mentioned in the petition.

A status report has been filed by learned State counsel,

wherein, it has been mentioned that no representation dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) has been received in the office of the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Hoshiarpur but after the receipt of the order passed by this Court, both the parties were summoned to the police station and their statements have been recorded but the petitioner during the said process, did not adduce any evidence so as to infer threat to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7 but still as a preventive measure, a DDR No. 25 dated 09.01.2022 has been registered under Section 107, 150 Cr.P.C. against respondents No. 4 to 7.

Learned State counsel further submits that in case petitioner apprehends any threat to her life and liberty, she will be at liberty to approach the concerned police authorities with appropriate representation and in case any representation is received from the petitioner with some cogent evidence, appropriate action, if needed, will be undertaken by the police without any delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
