Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.67 dated 03.04.2019, under Sections 427, 447, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 10.09.2019, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 18.03.2020 of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar. Learned Magistrate has stated the compromise is genuine, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.67 dated 03.04.2019, under Sections 427, 447, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
