Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was relieved from service on 07.07.2021 without giving any reason. The further prayer of the petitioner is that even the arrears of the salary from 13.06.2012 to 07.07.2021 have not been paid to him, which is causing prejudice to him.

On being asked as to whether, the petitioner has raised any grievance before the authorities concerned qua the issue being raised before this Court in the present petition, learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that he has not done so far.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner requests that he be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the respondents for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition at the first instance by filing appropriate representation.

Learned State counsel states that in case, any grievance is raised

by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy of representation before the authorities.

Ordered accordingly.
