1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P-1, dated 21.05.2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-13543-2019, was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide representations submitted by the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent states that claim of the petitioner as contained in the representations was decided vide order Annexure R/1 and cheque No.861323 dated 03.06.2020, for an amount of Rs.33,93,000/-, was sent to the petitioner and that in the circumstances, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

4. None is present on behalf of the petitioner. However, in the circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter.

5. In view of the position noted above, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the

Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition if cause survives.
