Mr. Sanjay Kaushal, learned Senior Counsel has submitted that on 10.12.2021 the petitioner had himself volunteered to deposit half of the disputed amount with the GST Authorities subject to final adjustment. He further submitted that he has now deposited half of the disputed amount, amounting to Rs. 1.25 crores with the GST Authorities and he has also joined the investigation in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 10.12.2021 and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and has provided all the documents to the investigating agency.
