Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.369 dated 26.08.2021, registered at Police Station City Mohindergarh, District Mohindergarh, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 447, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Vide order dated 23.11.2021, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner with a direction to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has tried to contact with the petitioner, but he could not be contacted, therefore, he has no instructions, as to whether the petitioner has joined the investigation or not.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vikash, submits that despite availing ample opportunities, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner way back on 23.11.2021, but even after granting ample opportunities, the petitioner has not joined the investigation, thus, the conduct of the petitioner shows disrespect to the orders passed by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
