The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.3 to 7, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-4), made to him by the petitioners in this regard and take appropriate action on the same.

As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. The year of birth of petitioner No.1 is 2002 and Date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 01.01.1990. Copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. They got married on 19.09.2022 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to look into the representation dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same expeditiously and also take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, in accordance with law.
