This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.8 dated 09.03.2020, under Sections 365, 336, 506, 342, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 307/392 IPC, 1860 and Section 3 SC & ST Act, 1985 and Section 395 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 24.11.2021, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 09.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court in CRM-M-46873-2021.

Notice of motion for 04.02.2022.

Meanwhile, in case, the petitioner appears before the concerned Court, he be released on interim regular bail.

To be heard along with CRM-M-46873-2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 24.11.2021, the petitioner submitted himself before the trial Court on 13.12.2021 and was admitted on interim regular bail.

The above position is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner shall remain on regular bail and on the same bail bonds/surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 13.12.2021.
