As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs and Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant No.1-Sunita w/o Rajinder Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs and Fifty Thousand Only) in the name of appellant No.1-Sunita w/o Rajinder Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok

Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
