Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the transfer of the petitioner has been effected without adhering to the provisions of the transfer policy including the fact that the stations near to the present place of posting are lying vacant where the petitioner could have easily accommodated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by filing a representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Budhwar, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) within a period of two weeks of the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 12.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
