In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that he has been transferred by ignoring the provisions of the transfer policy itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the last date for opting the stations was prescribed as 31.07.2022 whereas the rationalization policy had come after that which has caused prejudice as the petitioner has not been able to opt for the stations which has become available as per the rationalization policy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as a disciplined Teacher, the petitioner accepted the transfer and joined the transferred post and submitted a representation as required under the transfer policy but the petitioner has a right to be considered against the post of PGT English, which are still lying vacant near to his present place of posting, which facts

needs to be considered by the respondents so as to revise the order of transfer of the petitioner dated 28.08.2022, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case the representation which the petitioner submitted on 04.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) is decided by the respondents in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that representation of the petitioner dated 04.09.2022 (Annexure P-9), if not already decided, will be decided within a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and the grievance raised by the petitioner in the representation will be looked into and appropriate order will be passed addressing the same and in case any of the grievance of the petitioner, if found meritorious, the relief being claimed will be granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present writ petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
