The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of regular bail in FIR No.50 dated 8.6.2021, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 at Police Station Cantt. Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that in the petitioner's trial, the entire prosecution evidence has already been led and therefore, at this stage, the petitioner be not granted regular bail.

In the light of the above statement made by learned State counsel, at the fag end of the petitioner's trial, this Court does not deem it fit to grant regular bail to the petitioner and therefore, the present petition is dismissed.

However, directions are issued to the trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial within three months from the next date fixed before it, in accordance with law.
