1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.03.2019, in CWP-3037-2017.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-3037-2017, was disposed of vide order dated 08.03.2019, by directing the respondents to pass an appropriate order qua claim for release of pensionary benefits to the petitioner, which had been withheld by the respondents on account of the pendency of charge-sheet dated 24.12.2015 within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and further to release the amount whatever the petitioner was found entitled to, within one month thereafter.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondents have released financial benefits to the petitioner as per his entitlement and in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
