Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though,  
initially the petitioners were not declared selected against the posts  
advertised and were put in waiting list but, thereafter the petitioners were  
brought within the selected list keeping in view the various developments,

which occurred after the declaration of result hence, the petitioners are entitled for grant of appointment keeping in view the said fact that now the petitioners are within the selected list keeping in view the posts advertised.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are not being appointed by the respondents and that too without any reason.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners raising the said grievance before the authorities concerned along with the supporting documents, the same will be considered in accordance with law keeping in view the aspect of present selection and an appropriate order will be passed by the respondents within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation and in case, it is found that the petitioners are meritorious enough, an appropriate relief will be granted to them within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present writ petition and the same may be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents raising their claim by way of filing a representation.

Ordered accordingly.
