The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to withdraw application No.87 dated 07.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) marked by him to SHO, Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana in which the petitioners had requested for re-investigation in case FIR No.155 dated 02.08.2019 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered by respondent No.5-Inderjit Singh against the petitioners.

Short reply by way of an affidavit dated 04.02.2020 of Sh.Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS, ACP (South), Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record. As per the said reply, inquiry has already been conducted on the application No.87 dated 07.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) by the SHO, Police

Station Dehlon, Ludhiana and ACP (South), Ludhiana and ADCP-2, Ludhiana also agreed with this report. The Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has also approved this inquiry report.

In view of the above-said reply, no further action is required to be taken in the present petition which has become infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to avail their alternative remedies in accordance with law, if so advised.
