AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 164 dated 16.9.2021, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Division No. 5, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

The petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 3.3.2022 but he had not joined investigation.

On the last two dates, the matter was adjourned as none was present on behalf of the petitioner and opportunities were granted to the petitioner to join investigation.

As per instructions of learned counsel for the State, the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of best efforts, she has not been given any instructions and is not in a position to pursue the present petition.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner, no case is made out
for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petition is dismissed.
