Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.226 dated 16.10.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 24.11.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.11.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has also submitted that the compromise has also been arrived at between the parties and petition under Section 13-B of HMA Act has already been filed in which first motion statement has been recorded.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 24.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
