Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an appeal/representation was filed by the petitioner on 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-15) raising the grievance against the order dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-14) passed by respondent No.2 whereby, the claim of the petitioner for retrospective promotion was declined. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the expiry of more than 4 months, the said appeal/representation has not been decided, hence, the petitioner will be satisfied in case, appropriate direction is given to the authority concerned to decide the appeal/representation dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-15) in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the appeal/representation dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-15) filed by the petitioner, has not been decided so far, the same will be decided within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned State counsel further submits that in case, after the decision of the said appeal/representation dated 17.05.2022, any other benefit needs to be extended to the petitioner, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
