Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 17.08.2019, under Sections 498-A, 323 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

By virtue of the order dated 19.02.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and returned the gold rings as well, fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made

absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that some gold articles still remains to be recovered.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 19.02.2020, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
