Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.741 dated 14.9.2021 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC (sections 342, 376, 511 I.P.C were added later on) at Police Station, City Karnal, district Karnal.

By virtue of the order dated 24.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 24.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
