Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.0083 dated 09.08.2022 under Sections 452/323/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

The learned State counsel has filed short reply dated 07.12.2022 by way of an affidavit of Sh. Jasvir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Batala, with the additional charge of Sub Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 28.09.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 30.10.2022 and his further

investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.09.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
