By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.57, dated 16.06.2021, having been registered at Police Station Bajakhana, Distrcit Faridkot, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 22(a)/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (with Sections 29/61/85 of the said Act, added later).

Pursuant to the order dated 24.11.2021, learned State counsel submits, on instructions from SI Lakhbir Singh, that the petitioner having joined investigation, his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.
