In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the order dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar, by which the pensionary benefits admissible to the petitioner have been stopped, is totally arbitrary, illegal and contrary to the rules governing the service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has already been allowed voluntary retirement in the year 2014, which order still exists, hence, stopping of the pensionary benefits of the petitioner is totally arbitrary and illegal and the same has been stopped without holding any inquiry into the allegations levelled against the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has instructions to submit that order dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to the authority concerned to pass appropriate fresh order in accordance with law in case, the same is permissible.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order has already been withdrawn, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that respondents will be at liberty to pass a fresh order in accordance with law.
