Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.06 dated 13.02.2020, under Sections 406 and 498-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 26.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to order dated 26.11.2021, petitioners have joined the investigation and got the recovery of the dowry articles effected.

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Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that some of the dowry articles remain to be recovered.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
