1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 3.9.2021, in CWP-36196.

2. Notice was issued to respondent No.1 only.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab has filed reply alongwith speaking order Annexure R-1/T dated 20.11.2021. The same is taken on record, copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the reply as well as order Annexure R-1 states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R-1 dated 20.11.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel

for the petitioner,the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 20.11.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
