This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner claims himself to be a disabled ex-serviceman.

Petitioner had applied for allotment of an EWS flat in Gurugram pursuant to an advertisement issued in the year 2014 (Annexure P-1)

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of being the only disabled ex-serviceman who had applied for allotment, no formal letter of allotment has been issued and even a legal notice dated 01.08.2021 (Annexure P-14) having been served, no response has been evoked.

Counsel having argued the matter at length, seeks withdrawal of the writ petition on the ground that certain information has been sought under the provisions of the Right to Information Act and which has not been supplied to him till date.

He submits that the petitioner would pursue his remedies under the Right to Information Act itself to procure relevant information and would approach this Court thereafter, if need be and by raising grounds as may be available as per law.

In the light of the prayer and submission advanced, writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
