The instant petition had been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to take appropriate action against the respondents No.4 and 5 who have attempted to forcibly recover the vehicle of the petitioner in violation of the notification dated 28.09.2006 issued by the Reserve Bank of India and in breach of the judicial pronouncement of constitutional Bench of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of "*Citicorp Maruti Finance Limited versus S. Vijaya Laxmi, 2012 (1) SCC1* and "*ICICI Bank Ltd. Versus Prakash Kaur and others, 2007 (2) RCR (Criminal) 76*.

At the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the outstanding amount as per the respondents is Rs. 29,184/- and that he undertakes to deposit the entire

amount within a period of 06 weeks from today.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents No.4 and 5 contends that in the event of the petitioner depositing the entire outstanding amount of Rs.29,184/- within a period of six weeks as undertaken by the petitioner today in Court, they shall not initiate any steps for re-possession of the vehicle bearing registration No. PB 10 DS 4325.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition .

The same is thus dismissed accordingly.

It is however made clear that the petitioner shall remain bound by the statement to pay the outstanding amount of Rs.29,184/- within a period of six weeks as undertaken by him today in the Court.
