1. Learned DAG, Haryana states that vide order of Hon'ble the Division Bench dated 21.11.2022 in LPA No.1039-2022, operation of judgment of CWP-9471-2020 has been stayed, therefore, in the circumstances, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

2. None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned State counsel, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter. Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of* at this stage as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the order of stay is vacated/modified or the LPA filed by the State is decided in favour of the petitioner, whichever is earlier.
