[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 21.02.2017 in CWP No.19092 of 2016.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order, Annexure P/1 which has attained finality on dismissal of the SLP filed against the said decision, the petitioner has received payment as per entitlement as mentioned in order, Annexure P/1, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
