The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner on account of continuous threats and harassment given by respondent No.3 at the instance of respondent No.4; to decide the representations dated 22.10.2021 and 18.11.2021 (Annexure P-4 and P-5 respectively) and also for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to release the vehicle (Maruti make bearing registration No.PB-08-DT-4394), which is in his illegal possession without any authority.

In compliance with the order dated 09.12.2021, status report by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has been filed and the same is taken on

A perusal of the aforesaid status report filed by State would reveal that on the same allegations, petitioner No.1 had also moved representations bearing UID Nos.2205543 and 2206305 dated 05.12.2021 and 06.12.2021 respectively and enquiry on the said representations was got conducted by SI Puran Singh of P.S.Sahnewal, Ludhiana. Petitioner No.1 was joined in the said enquiry and her statement was got recorded, whereby petitioner No.1 stated that she does not want any action on the above said representations as her confusion has been removed. It was further revealed in the said enquiry that the petitioners were never harassed nor threatened by respondent No.3, rather respondent No.4 had moved a representation with the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana bearing UID No.2023281 dated 01.05.2021 against the petitioners and it was in connection with the enquiry of this representation that petitioner No.1 was joined by respondent No.3, but petitioner No.1 was never harassed nor threatened by respondent No.3.

In view of the aforesaid status report filed by State, no further action is required to be taken and accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
