The prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondent nos.1 & 3 for producing the detenue Ms. Shashi sister of the petitioner presently in illegal detention of respondent no.4.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The Counsel for the State submits that at the instance of the petitioner, FIR No.517 was registered under Sections 346 against unknown persons. Pursuant to police investigation an untrace report has been filed in this case. Prior to that all efforts had been made to trace the alleged detenue but she could not be traced despite best efforts.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in this case at this stage.
