The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of DDR No.24 dated 10.11.2020 registered under sections 323, 354, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station, Khilchian, District Amritsar Rural along with the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit (Annexures P-2 & P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the FIR in question was lodged due to misunderstanding between the parties. It is submitted that both the parties have amicably settled the dispute with the intervention of respectables and prosecution of the petitioners in the present FIR is nothing but an abuse of the process of law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1-State and Ms. Manpreet Kaur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of private respondents.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that the matter is under investigation and challan is yet to be presented.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the investigating agency to conclude the investigation in the present case after taking into consideration all the aspects, within a period of one month from today in accordance with law. However, the parties are at liberty to avail the alternate remedies as may be available to them in accordance with law.
