**MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)**

The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.100 dated 18.07.2021 registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka, under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balkar Singh from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 25.11.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail,

as extended to the petitioner vide the said order dated 25.11.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
