HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits, for which the petitioner became entitled for upon her retirement on 30.09.2017.

Learned State counsel submits that keeping in view the reply filed, there was a criminal case pending against the petitioner at the time of her retirement, keeping in view of which, certain benefits for which the petitioner was entitled for upon her retirement, were withheld by the respondents, but now all the benefits, for which she was found entitled for, have already been released in favour of the petitioner, and therefore, no grievance of the petitioner in this regard should subsist as of now.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though he has

no instructions about the same but in view of the submissions which have been made by learned State counsel in the Court today, as recorded hereinbefore, the same need not be doubted. Hence no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as such as not pressed any further at this stage, but with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents, in case any of her grievances still remain to be redressed by the respondents by filing an appropriate representation before the authorities concerned and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any grievance is raised by the petitioner by filing any representation, then it will be decided within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation by passing appropriate speaking order.

Disposed of as having not been pressed any further with the liberty prayed for.
