[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 19.08.2021 in CWP No.16014 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.16014 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 17.12.2018 as representation moved by the petitioner and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within 01 month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Pursuant to notice issued to respondent No.2, reply has been filed along with speaking order (Annexure R-3/T), consigning the representation of the petitioner to the record room by taking note of the position that the petitioner had filed a Court case to establish herself alone as the legal heir of the deceased and that in the absence of any order from the Court, pensionary benefits could not be given to the petitioner alone.

[5] None is present on behalf of the petitioner.

[6] Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, to furnish copy of the reply to learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

[7] In view of the position noted above as well as speaking order (Annexure R-3/T) dated 16.11.2021 having been passed by the General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Nangal in compliance with orders (Annexure P-1) dated 19.08.2021, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[8] The instant petition is accordingly *disposed of* as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to take appropriate proceedings in accordance with law to seek redress of her grievance *qua* order (Annexure R-3/T) / move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause subsists.
