The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the signal dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P-3) vide which the petitioner has been posted from the present location to 223 Battalion, and further quashing the order dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) vide which the request of the petitioner for allowing him to stay at the present location till completion of his tenure as per the transfer policy, was rejected; along with certain other prayers.

Since this is the matter involving transfer of the petitioner, who is member of the disciplined force and the stage of the next summer chain transfers have also arrived, therefore, it is of no use to keep the case pending here. Rather, the matter can be disposed off by restraining the

respondents not to transfer the petitioner till the process of summer chain transfers 2022 is initiated by them.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, the respondents shall not transfer the petitioner from his present place of posting till the summer chain 2022 transfer exercise is initiated by the respondents.
