The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the condition No.4.2 of the advertisement No.04 of 2018 (Annexure P-3) as issued by the Punjab Police Service Commission, Patiala inviting applications for filling up 20 posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police, which clause/provisions lays down that no age relaxation shall be permissible for Punjab Police Services.

Learned counsel for the petitioners herein would argue that the petitioners were already in service as Senior Laboratory Attendant and Inspector, Food Civil and Supplies and sought to join the Punjab Police as Deputy Superintendent of Police, however, there was a age limit that was stipulated in the said advertisement, which would debar the petitioners herein for being considered for recruitment to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

It appears that the petitioners herein appeared for the said examination, even though there is no such order by this Court available on the record of this writ petition permitting them to do so and having participated in the said examination, it appears that the petitioners herein have not even qualified.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners herein does not press the instant writ petition and seeks to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
