Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his other family members from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 25.09.2019, pursuant reply dated 02.12.2019 by way of affidavit of Simrat Pal Singh Dhindsa, PPS, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Detective), Ludhiana has been filed by the State. Learned State counsel makes a reference to para No.5 thereof, which reads thus:-

“That accordingly respondents no.4 to 7 were arrested and bailed out on 09.02.2019. Weapon of offence i.e. Kirpaan has also been recovered from respondent no.4. Statements of the witnesses u/s 161 Cr.P.C. have also been recorded on 25.01.2019 and after completion of the investigation, Challan/ Final Report u/s 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared and the same has also been submitted before the Ld. Trial Court 15.11.2019 and now the trial is pending in the Court of Ms. Baljinder Kaur, Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana and is fixed for for consideration on framing of Charges.”

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy, available to him, in accordance with law.
