Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Faridkot, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. In this affidavit, after verifying the details of the inquiry conducted and recording of statement of the petitioner as well as statement of respondent No.4, it is stated that there

is overwhelming evidence in support of respondent No.4 that the petitioner has got the present FIR registered on false averments. It is further submitted that cancellation report is prepared and the same will be submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 06 weeks from today.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a protest petition before the Illaqa Magistrate, if so advised.
