Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.67 dated 24.09.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Patiala.

Vide order dated 26.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.11.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court and both the parties appeared before it and the matter has been finally settled.

The report of the Mediator has also been received showing that the mediation remained successful.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed the said fact.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
