Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of the order dated 21.08.2019 passed in FIR No.23 dated 03.03.2016 registered at Women Police Station, District Yamuna Nagar, for offences under Sections 498-A, 377, 506, 34, 323, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC"), vide which application filed by the petitioner under Section 319 Cr.P.C for summoning respondents No.2 and 3 and for addition of charge under Section 377 IPC, has been dismissed.

There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner as well as respondents No.2 to 5 on the previous date of hearing. The matter was adjourned for today with an order that intimation of listing of the case be given to counsel representing the private parties.

As per office report, counsel for the private parties have been informed about the date fixed. However, there is no representation on their behalf.

It seems that they are not interested in pursuing the matter.
