The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 18.08.2017 (dispatched on 30.11.2017 (Annexure P-15).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that on account of amendment in the Act, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. He contends that liberty, however, be granted to the petitioners to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioners in accordance with law in the event of any fresh grievance.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberties as aforesaid.
