Main Case

[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 04.07.2022 in CWP No.13260 of 2022 in case titled as Amarjit Kaur vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.13260 of 2022 was disposed of as having been not pressed in view of the stand of learned DAG, Punjab that in case the issue with regard to grant of gratuity in respect of the services rendered by the late husband of the petitioner was still pending with the authorities concerned, appropriate orders on the same would be passed within two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondent No.1 has rejected the claim of the petitioner for grant of gratuity in respect of the services rendered by her late husband vide order dated 15.10.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 15.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
