The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to step up his pay at par with his junior Raj Kumar, w.e.f 04.03.2014 as the petitioner was given the basic pay of Rs.20,180/- whereas the said Raj Kumar was given basic pay of Rs.21,180/- and also on the date of his retirement on 31.08.2019 he was getting Rs.64,100 basic pay, whereas said Raj Kumar was getting the basic pay of Rs.66,000/- which is contrary to the mandate of Rule 12 of the HPGCL (ACP) Rules, 2016; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that the necessary order qua grant of scale to the petitioner has already been passed by the respondents. However, the said order has not been implemented by them so far. Hence, it is submitted that although, the writ petition has become infructuous, however, the respondents be

directed to release the consequent benefits to the petitioner within some time bound frame.

In view of the above, the petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, respondent No.2 is directed to release the benefits to the petitioner as per the order dated 07.01.2022 passed by respondents themselves; within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
