

GURDEV SINGH V/S GURTAJ SINGH AND ANR.

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On 18.12.2019, on behalf of the appellant, statement was made by learned counsel for the appellant that appellant would be satisfied if another sum of ₹1,20,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the MACT concerned is granted to him in full and final settlement of the claim in the present appeal and in that eventuality, his client would give up his claim regarding interest on the enhanced amount from the date of filing of the petition before the MACT, which is 23.02.2016. Statement of learned counsel for the appellant was also recorded on that day to this effect. Thereafter, case was being adjourned for 2-3 dates of hearing for seeking concurrence of the respondent-Punjab Roadways.

Today, Mr.Gurmeet Singh, Sr. Assistant, in the office of the General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has appeared and stated that he has been authorized to make statement on behalf of the General Manager, Punjab Roadways, Sri Muktsar Sahib. He has further stated that the General Manager has agreed to the proposal of the appellant. He has also brought a cheque bearing No.940509 dated 09.05.2022 drawn on Indian Bank Muktsar (06402) in the sum of ₹1,20,000/- (₹ One lakh Twenty Thousand Only) in favour of the appellant - Gurdev Singh, which has been handed over to learned counsel for the appellant against proper receipt. Statement of representative of the General Manager, Punjab

Roadways, Sri Muktsar Sahib has also been recorded separately to this effect.

Thus, as agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and representative of the respondent—Punjab Roadways, Sri Mauksar Sahib (separately recorded), a sum of ₹1,20,000/- (₹ One Lakh Twenty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
