Quashing of FIR No.414 dated 1.7.2015 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad, District Fatehabad and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide judgment and order of sentence dated 17.18.08.2018 passed by Ld.Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehabad, the petitioners were convicted under Sections 148 IPC and Sections 341, 323 and 506 read with Section 149 IPC. The maximum sentence awarded was Two years. They challenged the said judgment in appeal before Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad. During the pendency of the appeal, a compromise is stated to have been arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 02.03.2020, parties were directed to appear before learned Appellate Court concerned for recording their statements and a report was called from the said Court regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of Ld. Additional District and Sessions Judge, Fatehabad has been received, wherein, it is stated that compromise between the parties is genuine and valid.

In view thereof, petition is allowed. FIR No.414 dated 01.07.2015 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners are quashed.
