1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 13.05.2022, in CWP-10196-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-10196-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide representation dated 25.02.2022, submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has filed reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 along with speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 12.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 25.02.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 12.12.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 12.12.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent No.1 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
