The instant writ petition has been preferred by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take appropriate measures and redress the grievances being espoused in the present petition i.e. the limit of the petitioners to sell the Stamp Papers be increased; online E-stamping be stopped and percentage in commission for the sale of Government Stamp Papers be increased.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he would be satisfied in case the respondents are directed to take a decision on the aforesaid representation submitted by the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Vivek Chauhan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being accepted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.1 with a comprehensive representation espousing all grievances and in the event of such representation being submitted by the petitioners, an appropriate order thereupon shall be passed within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the concerned parties

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
