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RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (oral)

It is observed that previous petition filed by the petitioner for the same relief i.e. Civil Writ Petition No. 16086 of 2022 was disposed of by this Court on 27.07.2022 on the statement made by learned counsel appearing for Indian Oil Corporation that they would consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner as far as possible within a period of 45 days. However, the said appeal is stated to be still pending adjudication before the Appellate Authority.

Though in the given circumstances, prima-facie, we are of the view that the second writ petition upon the same cause of action perhaps would not even be maintainable. Be that as it may, learned counsel for the Indian Oil Corporation, on advance copy, submits that the matter as such is under review of the authority. In fact, a Committee had been constituted to consider the concerns/grievances of the petitioner, which has since submitted its report. Therefore, it is urged that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be decided within 10 days from today and decision in this regard shall be communicated to the petitioner.

Taking the statement of learned counsel appearing for Indian Oil Corporation on record, the petition filed by the petitioner stands disposed of.
